A REPORT ON COMMUNICATIVE SKILLS PROGRAMME

ON 30.06.2017

The communicative skills programme was held on 30.06.2017 from 1p.m to 4p.m. for all the teaching staff, non-teaching staff and security guards in the conference hall.

Our esteemed Principal Shri.M. Krishna Mohan began the session with a key note address. He elaborated the objectives and the purpose of this dream project.

It was an interactive session where teachers expressed the difficulties faced by the students in conversing in English. The teachers expressed their deep concern and the need of the hour to improve communication skills among the students. A discussion was initiated on why the students find it difficult to speak in English fluently. It was rightly said that students sometimes lack confidence due to poor communicative skills. Influence of regional language, peer pressure, being first generation learners, lack of guidance, lack of proper utilization of vocabulary, mother tongue influence, lack of guidance and support at home, poor or no reading habits were the reasons for students not being able to converse in English fluently.

Teachers were formed into groups of three and conversational cards and comprehension cards were distributed. Each group presented the structures, explained them very clearly and they were able to present the vocabulary in a befitting manner. The outsourcing staff and the security guards were also appraised of the situation and were instructed to use English in communicating with the stake holders.

In continuation of the programme teachers prepared their own conversational cards based on very interesting real life situation and presented the structures based on the conversation.

An interactive session on how to improve communicative skills among the students was discussed. It was also observed by all that the improvement in communicative skills in English will help students to score well in subjects in English medium. All the teachers pledged to take up this project in letter and spirit and enable students to converse and communicate in English fluently.

Team efforts of the Resource Persons Mr.C.Venkat Reddy(TGT Maths), Mrs. Virginia Sunder Raj(TGT English), Mrs. R.Madhuri(TGT Science) and both the teaching and the non-teaching staff had an enriching session on communicative skills.
